
YEAR 2

Key Question: How has our past formed the world we see today?

Topic: The Great Fire of London / Time travellers

Project: Fire experiment and design.

WOW event: Tudor dress up day which will include baking bread and making Tudor houses.

The children will have the chance to explore this text in detail and use it to inspire their own writing. We will focus on using high level vocabulary, a range of sentence types and a variety of punctuation within our writing this term. We will be exploring a mixture of fiction and non fiction texts as well as key historical events.

Maths – This term in Maths, students will be focusing on applying their knowledge in order to solve mathematical problems. We will be looking at data, measurement and time. Student will also continue to look at mathematical operations, calculations and symbols.

Science – **Materials** Our focus is materials and conducting our own experiments. We will be identifying and comparing the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses.

History and Geography – We will be traveling to 1666 and comparing London to the modern day. During this adventure we will also be making comparisons between opinions of King Charles before the fire and public opinion of him after the fire.

Art and Design – This term we will be looking at planning and developing our ideas. We will also be using tools and materials to create a product and then evaluating our product by identifying strengths and areas for improvement.


RE – In RE we will be exploring and debating the following questions; Should Jewish people always respect God? How important is it to Christians that Jesus came back to life after the crucifixion?

PSHE – We will aim to understand and respect the similarities and differences between people.

Computing – Year 2 will understand that algorithms are a set of instructions that solve specific problems and use this skill to create and write a program using precise and unambiguous instructions.
