

YEAR 2 - Butterfly and Grasshopper Class.

Key Question: What is special about our world?

Topic: Africa

Project: African dancing and music performance





English: Our power of reading text this term is: Lila and the Secret of the Rain by David Conway. The children will have the chance to explore this text in detail and use it to inspire their own writing. We will focus on using high-level vocabulary, a range of sentence types and a variety of punctuation within our writing this term.

Maths: This term we will be covering a selection of mathematics topics including number, place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, measurement and shape.

Science: Living things and their habitats and Animals including humans.

We will be identifying the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive. We will look at different habitats and environments and how animals are suited to their habitats. We will also discuss and explore the basic needs of humans and understand why exercise and nutrition is important.

History and Geography: We will use map skills to locate continents and oceans and look at their geographical features. Over the term we will compare Africa to the UK and explore habitats, animals and weather patterns linking to our science work.

Art and Design: The children will researching the Artist Edward Saidi Tingatinga and recreating his work through printing and painting.

Performing Arts/Music : Year 2 will be supported by our Trust Dance Teacher to create a dance to African music.

RE: They will be learning to re-tell the Easter story and understand what Jesus' resurrection means for Christians.

PSHE: The children will explore their own family life, home and school and compare these to children's family life, homes and school from around the world which are different from their own. In this unit, children also learn about the relationship between people and their environment and how this affects their way of life.

Computing: Year 2 will learn how to use technology purposefully to plan, create and review music patterns and projects.

French: The children will continue their Camembear adventures by learning how to count up to 10 in French

RECIPE: As part of the Skills for Life Trust, we promote and encourage all pupils to try and follow these values: Respect, Excellence, Cooperation, Independence, Perseverance and Enjoyment.
