YEAR 4

Classes: Badger and Fox

Topic for the Term: Ancient Egypt

Key Learning Question: What is unique

about Ancient Egypt?

To celebrate the learning about Ancient Egypt, the children will be having a trip to Kent Life to take part in workshops. There will be more details to follow in a separate letter.



English

We will be looking at the following text: There's a Pharaoh in our bath!

Our focus will be around story writing and creating our own Egyptian themed stories. We will be focusing on the different grammar and punctuation that is needed to improve our sentence writing as well as how we plan, organise and develop our ideas when writing longer pieces of work.

Maths

In maths this term, we will continue to develop our skills in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division in order to solve word problems. We will continue to strive for excellence in our times tables through Times Table Rock Stars.

Science

We will be learning about living things and their habitats. This will include learning about classifying different living things, vertebrates and invertebrates and using a key to classify animals. The learning will also include looking at our local habitats and environmental changes.

This will be led by Ms Jackson, a Secondary Specialist Teacher.

History

Our Ancient Egypt learning will continue with a focus on life during these times. The children will be learning about key Egyptologists and the importance of the tombs, temples and festivals as well as the mythology of the Gods.



Geography

We will continue our learning about key areas in the world focusing on environmental regions such as deserts and rainforests. We will be using the eight points of the compass and four-figure grid references to locate different areas on a map. We will also be learning about different countries and continents in the world and how they are divided into regions by the Equator and Hemispheres.

RE

The focus on this term's learning will be on Christianity and exploring different ways of showing forgiveness and whether this is always possible.

PSHF

One World is the topic of learning. During this topic we will be considering how people's lives are similar and different and show tolerance and understanding when people express opinions

different from their own. We will also be exploring climate change and organisations that work to help people around the world.

Art

This will link with our learning about Ancient Egypt. The children will be continuing to develop their drawing skills and learn some sculpture techniques.

This will be led by Mrs Sztyber, a Secondary Specialist Teacher.

Computing

Our focus this term will be on programming. We will be learning how to write programs to move a screen turtle, draw letters and create shapes. We will also learning to identify patterns and use repeats and loops in the programme.

PE

PE days will now be on a Monday and Friday. We will be focusing on Tag Rugby and Netball.

MFL

Mr Armstrong will be continuing to teach our MFL lessons. The topic for this term is Vive le sport which means our sporting lives.

Music

We will be continuing with our ukulele lessons each week, learning lots of different songs using strumming, plucking and chords.

Skills for Life Passport Activities

During this topic, we will be focusing on the following SFL passport activities which can be supported at home.

- I can care for living things (plants and animals)
- I can go on a hunt for small creatures
- I can look up where I live on a map

Homework

At Warren Wood Primary Academy, we believe that homework makes an important contribution to your child's learning. Homework can provide the opportunity to reinforce work completed at school or prepare for work coming up. It gives your child the opportunity to work independently, although you should support your child and take an interest in the work they are completing.


Weekly spellings (set on a Friday to be tested on the following Wednesday)

Uniform / PE Kit



We would ask that all children wear appropriate uniform at all times, including house team T-shirts for PE (available to purchase through Parent Pay). If there is a particular reason why your child is not in full uniform, please email the school.
