
Classes: Badger and Fox

Topic for the Term: Our bodies

Key Learning Question: What can I do to

live a healthy lifestyle?

To celebrate the learning about 'Our bodies', the children will be having a 'WOW' day focusing on how we can keep healthy.



English

We will be continuing to look at the following text: The Demon Dentist by David Walliams.

Our focus will be on applying the different features of both fiction and non-fiction writing. We will be focusing on the different grammar and punctuation that is needed to improve our sentence writing as well as how we plan, organise and develop our ideas when writing longer pieces of work.

Maths

In maths this term, we will continue to develop our skills in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division in order to solve word problems. We will continue to strive for excellence in our times tables through Times Table Rock Stars, and practising our strategies ready for the Multiplication Timetable Check at the beginning of the term.

Science

This term's learning will be focusing on sound. This will include how different sounds are made and how we hear those different sounds. These lessons will be led by Ms Jackson, a Secondary Specialist Teacher.



Geography and History

The learning focus for this term will be revisiting key skills from our previous learning. These will include exploring change, cause and effect, similarity and difference alongside securing knowledge of key time periods and their chronological order. The children will be securing their knowledge of the world and make comparisons between regions of the UK and the wider world.

RE

The focus on this term's learning will be on Christianity, and exploring how and where Christians worship.

PSHE

'Our Changing Bodies' is the topic of learning. We will be exploring how we grow and change both physically and mentally. A separate letter has been sent out outlining the lessons.

Art / DT

The learning will develop observational drawing skills considering perspective and proportion and include how we can use shade and tone. The children will also develop their design and making skills. These lessons will be led by Mrs Yssennagger, a Secondary Specialist Teacher.

Computing

Our focus this term will be on data logging. The children will be collecting data over different time periods and using the computer to help them analyse it.

PΕ

Our focus this term will be on athletics. This will include skills needed for running, jumping and throwing. We will also be learning and developing the skills needed for the different Sports Day events.

MFL

Mr Armstrong will be continuing to teach our MFL lessons. The topic for this term is Quel temps fait-il which means What is the weather like?

Music

We will be continuing with our ukulele lessons each week, learning lots of different songs using strumming, plucking and chords.

Homework projects will be completed using myOn. Teachers will set assignments on a Friday and these will need to be completed by the following Wednesday.


Children will also be taking home a list of spellings to learn and will be tested on them weekly.

Uniform / PE Kit
